- **Validity** – Typically **5–10 years** (multiple entry), depending on nationality
- **Maximum Stay** – Up to **6 months per visit**
- **Application Mode** – Online (DS-160) + In-person interview at the US Embassy/Consulate
- **Fee** – **\$185 (approx. AED 680)**

- Completed **DS-160** application form
- US visa appointment confirmation page
- Visa fee receipt
- UAE residence visa & Emirates ID copy
- Recent passport-size photograph (as per US visa specs)
- Proof of employment or business in UAE
- Bank statements or financial proof
- Travel itinerary (if applicable)
- Invitation letter (for B1 or family visit B2., If applicable)
- Any previous US visa details (if applicable)
